

ITEMS TO COLLECT OR MAKE FOR HARVESTCALL

The following items are needed by the hospitals, schools, and communities in Haiti, Mexico, Jamaica, Eastern Europe, or for projects in the United States:

Collect these:

1. **Office and school supplies**- especially any size envelope, any kind of routine office or school supplies, 3-ring binders, school bags, or tote bags, office chairs, and folding chairs. Advertising on items is fine.
2. **Sewing supplies** of any kind, as well as fabric (minimum size: 1 square yard)
3. **Common tools**, such as hammers, saws, etc, as well as electrical, woodworking, or plumbing tools. Flashlights and batteries.
4. **Baby items** are always needed.
5. **Surplus medical and hospital supplies** are needed. However, outdated medicine is NOT accepted. NO pill containers are needed.
6. **Bikes** in good condition.
7. **Eye glasses**: send to Dr. Bryan Stoller, 817 S. Locust, Pontiac, IL 61764. NO hearing aids.
8. **Food Items**: Nonperishable for local or international shipment
9. **Sheets & Towels**: Establish routes to pick up from hospitals (single sheets!) and motels. Please sort and box.
10. **Pillowcases** for Mexico
11. **Umbrellas** for Mexico
12. **Bibles, Hymn Books, and Bible Story Books.** (not Zion's Harp) These books are collected and repaired through the Goodfield Distribution Center 1478 U.S. Hwy #150, Goodfield, IL 61742

Please have the following items sorted:

13. **Clothing**: Should be clean and in good repair. No holes, etc. Sort into the following categories: men winter, men summer, women winter, women summer, children winter, children summer.
14. **Linens**: Household or hospital linens. Please sort as follows: sheets, pillowcases, blankets, hospital gowns, bed pads, etc.

Make the following:

Health Kits – Fill as noted.

School Kits – Fill as noted.

Flannel Diapers – With strings

Infant Layettes

Comforters – With no batting for warmer climates, with lightweight batting or heavy batting for cooler climates.

Health or School Kits bags – These will then be filled at the Distribution Center.

School Uniforms – They found a source to purchase them
